## **Much and Many**

We can use much and many to talk about quantities.

We can also use a lot of or lots of, but we will cover that in another lesson.

To ask about quantities, we use *how many* for things we can count and *how much* for things we can't count.

How *many* cookies are there in the packet?

How **much** water would you like?

There are *many* buses in my town.

My grandfather doesn't have *much* hair.

My father doesn't have *many* books.

For things we can't count [uncountable nouns], we use **much** in sentences and questions.

There was too **much** rain last week.

How *much* rain did you have last summer?

My teacher gives us too *much* homework.
