Round Robin Questions

Begin with one of your better students. Ask the student to look at the things on his/her desk and give you an example sentence with **IS**. Some possibilities can be:

This is my book/eraser/pencil case/ruler/backpack, etc. Drill students with *Singular, One item, Only One, How many items?*

Ask another student to give you an example sentence with **ARE**. Some possibilities can be:

There are many students/desks/chairs/pens in the class. Drill students with *Plural, Many items, many students, How many items?*

Ask if any student can give you a sentence with **AM**.

Some possibilities can be:

I am sitting on a chair. I am studying English. I am writing in my book. Am I a student? Am I studying English? Am I going home after class?
