

CAN CAN'T

Lesson Objectives

Students practice using the modals *CAN* and *CAN'T* in English. They learn that we use *CAN* with another verb.

Target Language

I / He / She / They / We can + verb rest of the sentence e.g:

I can bake a cake.

I can run fast.

I can wash my dog.

I can not / can't wash my cat.

I can't eat a large pizza.

I can't speak German.

Etc.

Pre-teach New Vocabulary [Word Library]

smoothie draw a face milk a cow
a piece of... pieces of... dairy products
omelet bark catch a fish
do sit-ups skip do push-ups

the "@" in an email address the . [dot] in an email address

etc.

Can is a modal verb.

Can + not [Cannot or Can't] is used for negative sentences.

Can and **Can't** are used to talk about abilities in the present, or to say that something is **possible** or **not** possible.

Can is different from other verbs - it is the same for all subjects. We don't add an 'S' in the third person.

Always use *Can* with another verb.
