



# SEQUENCING WORDS

## Lesson Objectives

How to use sequencing words.

How to give step-by-step instructions.

Students learn new vocabulary and how to use it in a sentence.

## Target Language

First, take the cord and plug it in.

Second, open the lid / door.

Next, put the food / clothes in.

Then, close the door / lid.

Press the button.

Etc.

## Vocabulary

Cord [cable], plug

Door / lid

Detergent, washing powder

Switch, button, start

Timer, clock, press

etc.

Why should you teach learners about sequencing?

Sequence words help your students understand the order of events in a story, a manual, or giving instructions. They're used when explaining or writing the order of steps that need to be completed to make or do something. They show or tell us the beginning, the middle, and the end.

Keep it simple. Begin with something easy that they are familiar with, like brushing your teeth... First, you open the toothpaste. Second, put some toothpaste on your toothbrush, etc. Make sure they understand the idea of the beginning, the middle, and the end.
