1. Green grocer - a shop selling fruit and vegetables
2. Trolley - like a big basket on wheels
3. Supermarket - a large shop selling foods and household goods
4. Till - cash register at the checkout counter
5. Market - a place that sells fruit, vegetables and other commodities
6. Cash - money in notes and coins
7. Elevator - lift
8. Alley - a narrow passageway
9. Barcode - a code in the form of numbers and parallel lines
10. Change room - fitting room
11. Stall - fruit and vegetable stalls at a market
12. Shelf - a surface for the storage of goods
13. Bill - the amount of money owed

1. Grocery store - a smaller version of a supermarket
2. Cart = trolley
3. Department store - bigger than a supermarket, also sells furniture, etc.
4. Register = till
5. Supermarket - a large shop selling foods and household goods
6. Cashier - the person that you pay at the checkout counter
7. Escalator - a moving staircase
8. Aisle - a passage between shelves in a supermarket
9. QR code - a code in the form of black and white squares
10. Fitting room = change room
11. Stand = stall, for the display of goods for sale
12. Rack = shelf
13. Receipt - proof of payment
