



YOUR TEACHER SAYS

1. You will read a sentence to your students and follow it up by saying: ... *and your teacher says, it's true/false.*

Example: Cats are better pets than dogs... *and your teacher says, it's true.*

2. Give your students a moment to think about this and they must then agree or disagree with you, and tell you briefly why.
3. Make some sentences *true and some false.* Have fun!
4. Depending on the size of your class, you can allow multiple students to answer/ debate your statement.

1. Sunny weather is always the best weather for going to the beach.
(Debatable because some people prefer shade or cooler temperatures at the beach.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
2. Cold weather makes you more productive.
(Debatable because some people find it harder to concentrate / get motivated in the cold.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
3. Rain is always bad for outdoor activities.
(Debatable: some activities are more enjoyable in the rain, like hiking or gardening.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
4. Snow is a major inconvenience.
(Debatable because some people love snow and the winter activities it brings.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
5. Hot weather is perfect for staying indoors with air conditioning.
(Debatable: some people enjoy the heat and prefer outdoor activities in hot weather.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
6. The best way to cool down on a hot day is with an ice cream cone.
(Debatable because some people might prefer a cold drink or a swim.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
7. Opening an umbrella indoors brings bad luck.
(Debatable because this is a superstition, not a weather fact.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
8. Fall is the most beautiful season because of the changing leaves.
(Debatable: some people prefer the vibrancy of summer or the fresh snow of winter.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
9. Wearing a hat is the best way to stay warm in the winter.
(Debatable because most of your body heat escapes from your head, but layering and covering your whole body is more effective.)
And your teacher says it's false/true.
