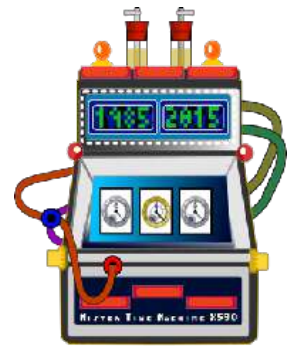




NUMBERS & TIME
