3. Ketchup is a vegetable. (False! Ketchup is a condiment made primarily from tomatoes, which are a fruit.)
4. Chewing gum takes seven years to digest in your stomach. (False! Thankfully, chewing gum doesn't get digested, it just passes through your system.)
5. The Great Wall of China is visible from space with the naked eye. (False! While it's incredibly long, the Great Wall is too thin to be seen from space without a high-powered telescope.)
6. Ostriches bury their heads in the sand when they are scared. (False! This is a myth. Ostriches actually lay flat on the ground to blend in with their surroundings when threatened.)
7. There are more stars in the universe than grains of sand on all the beaches on Earth. (True! As mentioned before, the vastness of space holds an unimaginable number of stars.)
8. Chocolate can actually improve your mood. (True! Chocolate contains chemicals that trigger the release of endorphins, which have mood-boosting effects.)
