Idioms - Doors

As one door closes another opens - if one thing you do fails, you will soon have an opportunity to try to succeed at something else

Leave the door open - ensure that there is still an opportunity for something.

Show him the door - tell someone to leave or make it clear you want someone to leave

Behind closed doors - taking place secretly, without public knowledge

Knock on the door - to be very close to achieving

| 3. Knob | A protective covering over the keyhole. |

| 5. Key | The wooden or metal structure that surrounds a door. |
| 6. Hinge | The movable part of a door that swings on hinges. |
| 7. Frame | The part of a door that connects it to the wall. |
| 8. Threshold | This is the piece that covers the sill. |
| 9. Panel | A device used to secure a door. |
| 10. Sill | An object used to open a locked door. |
