



# TAKING THE TRAIN

## 1. Role-Play Scenarios

### Scenario 1: Buying a Ticket

*[Use polite phrases such as "Excuse me," "Please," and "Thank you."]*

**Student A:** You are at the ticket counter. Buy a ticket to your destination.

- Greet the ticket seller.
- Ask for a one-way or round-trip ticket.
- Specify the destination.
- Ask about the price.
- Pay for the ticket.

**Student B:** You are the ticket seller. Help Student A buy a ticket.

- Greet the customer.
- Ask for the destination.
- Inform the customer of the ticket options and prices.
- Complete the transaction.

### Scenario 2: Asking for Directions

**Student A:** You are at the train station and need to find your platform.

- Approach a station staff member.
- Ask for directions to your platform.
- Confirm the platform number.
- Thank the staff member.

**Student B:** You are a station staff member. Help Student A find their platform.

- Greet the customer.
- Ask for their destination.
- Give clear directions to the platform.
- Confirm any additional information.
