## Terms associated with gender - General Terms

1. **Gender:** How society sees boys and girls, men and women.
2. **Sex:** Biological differences between boys and girls.
3. **Gender Identity:** How you feel inside about being a boy, girl, both, or neither.
4. **Gender Expression:** How you show your gender to others (clothes, hair, behavior).
5. **Cisgender:** When your gender identity matches the sex you were born with.
6. **Transgender:** When your gender identity is different from the sex you were born with.
7. **Non-binary:** Not just male or female; can be both or neither.
8. **Genderqueer:** Similar to non-binary; not fitting into just male or female.
9. **Gender Fluid:** Gender identity that can change over time.
10. **Agender:** Not identifying with any gender.

## Specific Terms

1. **AFAB (Assigned Female at Birth):** Born as a girl but may not feel like a girl.
2. **AMAB (Assigned Male at Birth):** Born as a boy but may not feel like a boy.
3. **Androgynous:** Looking or acting both male and female, or neither.
4. **Gender Dysphoria:** Upset because your gender identity doesn't match your body.
5. **Gender Binary:** The idea that there are only two genders: male and female.
6. **Gender Non-conforming:** Not acting the way society expects for your gender.
7. **Pronouns:** Words like he, she, or they used to refer to people.
8. **Ally:** Someone who supports and helps LGBTQ+ people.
9. **Intersectionality:** How different parts of your identity (like race and gender) can affect your life.
10. **Misgender:** Calling someone by the wrong gender pronoun.
