- 10. Hawkers who sell refreshments on the beach have the best view. And your teacher says it's false/true.
- 11. Building sandcastles is more fun than swimming in the ocean.
- 12. Packing a light lunch is better than buying expensive beach food.
- 13. The beach is more enjoyable in the morning than in the afternoon.
- 14. People-watching at the beach is more entertaining than reading a book.
