



## FUN ON THE BEACH

1. You will read a sentence to your students and follow it up by saying: ... *and your teacher says, it's true/false.*  
**Example:** Cats are better pets than dogs... *and your teacher says, it's true.*
2. Give your students a moment to think about this and they must then agree or disagree with you, and tell you briefly why.
3. Make some sentences *true and some false.* Have fun!
4. Depending on the size of your class, you can allow multiple students to answer/debate your statement.

9. Going to the beach is only for people with beautiful bodies.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
10. Hawkers who sell refreshments on the beach have the best view.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
11. Building sandcastles is more fun than swimming in the ocean.
12. Packing a light lunch is better than buying expensive beach food.
13. The beach is more enjoyable in the morning than in the afternoon.
14. People-watching at the beach is more entertaining than reading a book.
