Vocabulary

1. **Bullying** - Abuse and mistreatment of someone vulnerable by someone stronger, more powerful, etc.
2. **Racism** - The practice of discriminating against people based on their race or ethnic background.
3. **Ageism** - Ageism is prejudice or discrimination against a particular age group especially the elderly.
4. **Sexism** - Discrimination against people because of their sex: anything unfair to males or females, just because they're males or females.
5. **Equality** - a situation in which men and women, people of different races, religions, etc. are all treated fairly and have the same opportunities.
6. **Multiculturalism** - a society where many different cultures live together.
7. **Migration** - to move from one country, place, or locality to another.
