*Tickets, the others are more about participation and celebration.*
2. Music Festival, **Sports Tournament**, Film Festival, Food Festival  
*Sports Tournament is a competition, not a festival.*
3. Diwali, Hanukkah, **Thanksgiving**, Christmas  
*Thanksgiving, it is not a religious festival.*
4. parade, **food stalls**, live music, fireworks display  
*Food stalls are common at festivals, but the rest are all forms of entertainment.*
5. **Sunday**, Holi, Eid, Christmas  
*Sunday is a day of the week, not a festival.*
6. carnival, parade, costume party, **fireworks show**  
*Fireworks Show, it is not a festival on its own.*
7. Independence Day, Labor Day, **Mother's Day**, New Year's Eve  
*Mother's Day celebrates mothers, while the rest celebrate national or global events.*
8. Easter, **Ramadan**, Halloween, Valentine's Day  
*Ramadan is a month-long, and the others are single-day celebrations.*
