



## YOUR TEACHER SAYS

1. You will read a sentence to your students and follow it up by saying: ... *and your teacher says, it's true/false.*  
**Example:** Cats are better pets than dogs... *and your teacher says it's true.*
2. Give your students a moment to think about this and they must then agree or disagree, and tell you briefly why.
3. Make some sentences *true and some false.* Have fun!
4. Depending on the size of your class, you can allow multiple students to answer/ debate your statement.

9. Zebras eat grass.  
*... and your teacher says it's true/false.*
10. Donkeys are more beautiful than zebras.  
*... and your teacher says it's true/false.*
11. I want to play with a baby leopard.  
*... and your teacher says it's true/false.*
12. In winter, lions like to lie in the sun and do nothing.  
*... and your teacher says it's true/false.*
