



BUS BENEFITS

1. Driver - Pilot - Passenger - Conductor
Pilot (The rest are associated with bus travel, whereas a pilot is related to air travel)
2. Ticket - Platform - Engine - Seat
Platform (A platform is typically found in a train station, not a bus)
3. Bus stop - Route - Flight - Fare
Flight (The rest are related to bus travel, whereas a flight is related to air travel)
4. Cockpit - Steering wheel - Pedal - Aisle
Cockpit (The rest are parts of a bus, whereas a cockpit is part of an airplane)
5. Baggage - Luggage - Suitcase - Aisle
Aisle (Baggage, luggage, and suitcase are related to passenger belongings, while aisle is part of the bus)
6. Window - Door - Wing - Mirror
Wing (The rest are parts of a bus, whereas a wing is part of an airplane)
7. Altitude - Timetable - Map - Schedule
Altitude (The rest are related to planning a bus trip, whereas altitude is related to flying)
8. Driver - Runway - Wheels - Ticket
Runway (The rest are associated with bus travel, whereas a runway is associated with airplanes)
