- o In a relationship, in a hurry
- Used for time periods: In an hour, in two days
- Used for countries, states, and provinces: I live in the USA.
- ON Used for surfaces: On the table, on the wall
 - Used for devices or media: On TV, on the phone
 - Used for dates: On Friday, on January 1st
 - Used for events: On Christmas Day

AT - Used for specific addresses or locations: At 123 Main St, at the corner

- Used for specific times: At 5 pm, at noon
- Used for events or meetings: At the conference, at the party
