1. Furniture - desk, bed, bedside table, table, chair, sofa, etc.
2. Not furniture - linen, TV, kettle, pillows, cups and glasses, blankets, etc.
3. Bathroom - towels, taps, shampoo, soap, shower, toilet, basin, mirror.
4. Free in bathroom - soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush.
5. Rooms in a hotel - bedrooms, dining room, kitchen, lobby, store rooms, conference room, gym, spa, restaurant, office, etc.
6. People - receptionist, porter [bellboy], manager, chef, cleaning staff, customers.
7. Things to do - sleep, watch TV, have meetings, relax, training, conference, gym, have breakfast, lunch or dinner, etc.
8. Breakfast foods - cereals, bread rolls, pancakes, croissants, sweet pastries, toast, ham, bacon, sausages, scrambled eggs, fried eggs, omelets, tortillas, fruit, yogurt, hummus, olives, feta cheese, cucumbers, tomatoes, pita bread, rice porridge, steamed buns, dumplings, etc.
9. Cities - The biggest cities and tourist destinations in each country.
10. Bedding - sheets, duvet, throw, pillows, blankets.
11. Beverages in bar fridge - water, sodas, beer, fruit juice, energy drinks, wine, etc.
12. Corridors - pot plants, paintings, carpets, ornaments, console [narrow] tables, lamps.
