- 3. Bathroom towels, taps, shampoo, soap, shower, toilet, basin, mirror.
- 4. Free in bathroom soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush.
- 5. Rooms in a hotel bedrooms, dining room, kitchen, lobby, store rooms, conference room, gym, spa, restaurant, office, etc.
- 6. People receptionist, porter [bellboy], manager, chef, cleaning staff, customers.
- 7. Things to do sleep, watch TV, have meetings, relax, training, conference, gym, have breakfast, lunch or dinner, etc.
- 8. Breakfast foods cereals, bread rolls, pancakes, croissants, sweet pastries, toast, ham, bacon, sausages, scrambled eggs, fried eggs, omelets, tortillas, fruit, yogurt, hummus, olives, feta cheese, cucumbers, tomatoes, pita bread, rice porridge, steamed buns, dumplings, etc.
