## HAIR - AT THE SALON

1. You will read a sentence to your students and follow it up by saying: ... *and your teacher says, it's true/false.*  
**Example:** Cats are better pets than dogs... *and your teacher says, it's true.*
2. Give your students a moment to think about this and they must then agree or disagree with you, and tell you briefly why.
3. Make some sentences *true and some false.* Have fun!
4. Depending on the size of your class, you can allow multiple students to answer/debate your statement.

1. People with red hair are moody.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
2. Men with long hair are artistic.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
3. Black hair always looks good.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
4. Thick hair is too hot in summer.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
5. People with thin hair want thick hair and those with thick hair want thin hair.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
6. You should wash your hair every day.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
7. Girls with long hair are old-fashioned.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
8. Being bald is cool.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
9. If you have short hair you don't need to comb it in the morning.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
10. Spiky short hair with gel looks funky.  
*And your teacher says it's false/true.*
