

BORROW & LEND

Lesson Objectives

- Students learn to use "borrow" and "lend" correctly.
- Students practice using the target language in exercises.

Target Language

Asking to Borrow

- Can I borrow your [object]?
- May I borrow your [object]?
- Do you have a [object] that I can borrow?

Offering to Lend

- I will lend you my [object].
- · Lend me your [object], please.

Vocabulary

Borrow	Lena
I want to borrow	I can lend you
Can I borrow	I will lend you
I am going to borrow	I have lent

Borrow vs Lend

- Borrow: Take something from someone temporarily.
- Lend: Give something to someone temporarily.

Or, even simpler:

- Borrow: You take.
- · Lend: You give.

Examples: Borrow

- 1. I borrow my friend's book.
- 2. Can I borrow your phone charger?

Lend

- 1. I will lend my sister my bike.
- 2. My mom will lend me some money.
