

BE HAVE WEAR

Describing Appearance with BE, HAVE, and WEAR

Lesson Objectives

- Students will be able to use the verbs BE, HAVE, and WEAR correctly to describe physical appearance.
- Students will understand the differences between using BE for personal characteristics, HAVE for possession, and WEAR for clothing and accessories.
- Students will practice forming questions and statements using the target language.

Target Language

BE (Personal Characteristics)

- I am 39 years old.
- She is tall/thin/blond.
- · He is from Japan.

HAVE (Possession)

- I have blue eyes.
- My brother has short hair.
- She has a tattoo.

WEAR (Clothing and Accessories)

- I wear glasses.
- My sister wears a watch.
- He wears a suit to work.

- To have (HAVE)
- To wear (WEAR)
- Adjectives (e.g., tall, short, thin, chubby, shy)
- Nouns (e.g., hair, eyes, clothes, accessories)
