



# GET - THE MEANINGS

## Meanings of Get

### 1. To Become

Use *get* to describe a change or transformation.

1. Example: He got angry when he saw the mess.
2. Meaning: He became angry.

### 2. To Receive

Use *get* when talking about receiving something.

1. Example: I got a letter from my best friend today!
2. Meaning: I received a letter.

### 3. To Obtain

Use *get* to talk about obtaining or securing something, like a job or an item.

1. Example: She got tickets to the concert!
2. Meaning: She obtained tickets.

### 4. To Arrive

Use *get* to describe arriving at a place.

1. Example: We got to the airport just in time for the flight.
2. Meaning: We arrived at the airport.

### 5. To Travel

Use *get* when discussing how someone travels.

1. Example: Did you get home by train or bus?
2. Meaning: Did you travel home by train or bus?

### 6. To Convince

Use *get* when talking about persuading someone to do something.

1. Example: She got me to try skydiving, and I loved it!
2. Meaning: She convinced me to try skydiving.

### 7. Possession

Use *get* to indicate owning or having something.

1. Example: I've got a lot of books in my collection.
2. Meaning: I possess a lot of books.

### 8. Obligation

Use *get* to express something that needs to be done.

1. Example: We have got to clean the house before our guests arrive.
2. Meaning: We are obligated to clean the house.

### 9. To Understand

Use *get* when talking about understanding something.

1. Example: Do you get how this math problem works?
2. Meaning: Do you understand how this math problem works?

### 10. Opportunity

Use *get* to describe having the chance to do something.

1. Example: I get to visit my grandparents every summer.
2. Meaning: I have the opportunity to visit my grandparents.

### 11. To Start

Use *get* when talking about starting something.

1. Example: Let's get moving before the rain starts!
2. Meaning: Let's start moving.
