1. "I'd like a [meal/item], please."

Example: "I'd like a large cola, please."

2. "Can I have [item]?"

Example: "Can I have a double cheeseburger?"

3. "May I have [item], please?"

Example: "May I have a small fries, please?"

4. "Could I get [item]?"

Example: "Could I get a chicken burger?"

5. "I'll have [item], please."

Example: "I'll have the value meal, please."

Customizing Orders

6. "With [ingredient]."

Example: "With extra cheese."

7. "No [ingredient], please."

Example: "No onions, please."

8. "Can you add [ingredient]?"

Example: "Can you add ketchup?"

9. "Hold the [ingredient]."

Example: "Hold the pickles."

10. "Extra [ingredient], please."

Example: "Extra mayo, please."

Specifying Size or Quantity

11. "A small/medium/large [item], please."

Example: "A large soda, please."

12. "One/two/three [item], please."

Example: "Two hamburgers, please."

13. "Make it a combo."

Example: "I'll have a cheeseburger—make it a combo."

14. "Supersize it."

Example: "Supersize it with a large fries and drink."

15. "Add an extra [item]."

Example: "Add an extra side of fries, please."
