Explanations

1. **Holiday** - The other words are related to discounts, while "holiday" is more general.
2. **Restaurant** - The others are related to shopping or shoppers.
3. **Christmas** - The others specifically refer to Black Friday or shopping events, while Christmas is broader.
4. **Gift** - "Gift" doesn't directly refer to sales or stock, unlike the others.
5. **Doorbuster** - "Mall," "Checkout," and "Shopping" are general terms, while "Doorbuster" is a specific sale type.
6. **Gift Card** - "Inventory," "Price," and "Cart" are associated with shopping items, not payment methods.
7. **Price** - "Customer," "Deal," and "Queue" are about the shopping experience, while "Price" refers to cost.
8. **Package** - "Offer," "Purchase," and "Cashier" relate to transactions.
9. **Aisle** - "Refund," "Return," and "Discount" are related to purchases, while "Aisle" refers to store layout.
10. **Online** - "Receipt," "Price Tag," and "Sale" are in-store items, whereas "Online" refers to a location or platform.
