Read the details about Maria in the block to the Ss, normal speed. (Not too slow).

Mario's cousin, Maria, is a cashier. She works 8 hours a day, from 2 to 10:30 p.m. She has a 30 minute break at 7 p.m. She works 5 days a week, from Tuesday to Saturday.

Maria works 40 hours a week. She has two days off every week. This is her regular work week.
