



# CHRISTMAS

## Level: Beginner - Pre-intermediate

### Objectives:

- Students will be able to understand and use basic Christmas vocabulary.
- Students will practice using present and past tenses to describe Christmas traditions and memories.
- Students will develop their reading and speaking skills through Christmas-themed activities.

### Materials:

- Christmas vocabulary handout
- Christmas reading passage
- Worksheet for grammar and vocabulary practice

### Procedure:

1. Warmup discussion (5-15 minutes).
2. Introduction: Review winter holiday vocabulary and ask students true/false questions.
3. Vocabulary (10 minutes): Pre-teach key Christmas vocabulary using the *Library* handout.
4. Reading (15 minutes): Have students read the Christmas reading passage. Ask comprehension questions and discuss the passage as a class.
5. Grammar practice (15 minutes): Use the worksheets to practice present and past tenses in the context of Christmas traditions and memories.
6. Speaking (15 minutes): Divide students into pairs or small groups. Have them discuss their favorite Christmas traditions or memories using the vocabulary and grammar from the lesson.

### Assessment:

- Observe students during the speaking activity to assess their ability to use Christmas vocabulary and grammar correctly.
- Review their worksheets to assess their understanding of present and past tenses.

### Extension:

- Students to share their favorite Christmas traditions or memories with the class.

### Conversation Starters

- What's your favorite Christmas tradition?
- What do you usually do on Christmas Eve?
- What's the best Christmas gift you've ever received?
- Do you prefer a white Christmas or a warm Christmas?
- What's your favorite Christmas food or dessert?
