



CLASSROOM OBJECTS

Lesson Objectives

Learn the names of common classroom items and build your students' vocabulary.

Practice spelling, vocabulary, speaking, questions, and answers.

Target Language

There is a big world map on the wall. My books are in my backpack. Use an eraser when you make a mistake. Etc.

Vocabulary

Pen, pencil, book, sharpener, glue stick, glue, eraser, map, globe, notice board, etc.

Talkmor Suggestion:

- Begin the class by asking a few students questions about classroom objects.
Ask the 1st question to one of your better students:
 - Name one item (thing) in your backpack.
 - Name one item (thing) on your desk.
 - Name one item on my desk.
 - Name one item on the wall.
 - Name one item on your classmate's desk.
 - Name one item in your classmate's backpack. 🙄
 - Name one item you want but don't have in your bag.
- Ask students to interview each other. They can begin with what they have in their bags and what's on the table and then discuss what they see on the wall, on a shelf, etc.
- Teach / Write on the board:
 - There is a _____ in my bag / on the wall, etc.
 - There are some _____ in my bag / on the desk, etc.
