A. Lineup

Instructions

- 1. Form a small group of 4-5 students.
- 2. Choose one of the questions below and ask each other.
- 3. Line up in order from the shortest to the longest, based on your answers.
- 4. Explain your position in the line to the class.

Questions:

- 1. How long have you been doing your hobby?
- 2. How often do you do your hobby in a week?
- 3. How many hours do you spend on your hobby in a week?
- 4. How much money do you spend on your hobby in a month?
- 5. How many people do you usually do your hobby with?

Example:

- Question: How long have you been doing your hobby?
- Student A: 1 year
- Student B: 2 years
- · Student C: 6 months
- Student D: 3 years
- Lineup: Student C, Student A, Student B, Student D

Tips:

- Make sure to listen carefully to each other's answers.
- Ask follow-up questions to clarify if needed.
- Have fun and be prepared to explain your position in the line!
