Teacher's Key

Note for teachers: For future tense, both "will + verb" and present continuous with future time expressions are acceptable in most cases.

2. Present, Past, and Future Verb Tenses

- 1. Right now, John *is drinking* (drink) coffee during his break. [Present continuous]
- 2. Yesterday, we *had* (have) lunch at the new café. [Simple past]
- 3. Tomorrow, I <u>will meet / am meeting</u> (meet) my friends for tea after work. [Future: will or present continuous for future]
- 4. Every day, Sarah **takes** (take) a short walk during her lunch break. [Simple present]
- 5. Last week, they **went** (go) to the park during their free time. [Simple past]
- 6. Next weekend, he *will try / is trying* (try) that new restaurant downtown. [Future: will or present continuous for future]
- 7. Lisa usually **eats** (eat) a sandwich at her desk. [Simple present]
- 8. Two days ago, I brought (bring) cookies for everyone in the office. [Simple past]
- 9. Tonight, we <u>will watch / are watching</u> (watch) a movie during our evening break. [Future: will or present continuous for future]
- 10. Maria always <u>makes</u> (make) tea at 3 o'clock. [Simple present]
- 11. Last month, the company *opened* (open) a new break room for employees. [Simple past]
- 12. Next summer, they *will visit / are visiting* (visit) the beach during their vacation. [Future: will or present continuous for future]

Extension Activities:

- 1. **Time Line Activity**: Draw a timeline on the board and have students place each sentence in the correct position (past, present, or future).
- 2. **Break Time Schedule**: Have students write their own break schedule using all three tenses.
- **3. Chain Story**: Start a story about a lunch break and have each student add a sentence, alternating between tenses.
