A. Holiday Acting Game – Mime & Guess

How to play:

- One student chooses a holiday action without showing anyone.
- The student mimes the action.
- The others must guess the verb and say a sentence using the correct tense (Present, Past, or Future).

Example: Mime: Eating ice cream Guess: "He is eating ice cream." / "He ate ice cream yesterday." / "He will eat ice cream tomorrow."
