**Future**: They **will be** Egyptian scientists.

**Present**: I am a Chinese language student. **Past**: I was a Chinese language student.

Future: I will be a Chinese language student.

**Present**: The restaurant is Spanish. **Past**: The restaurant **was** Spanish.

Future: The restaurant will be Spanish.
