A. Warm-Up & Share

Student A: Discuss these questions with Student B.

1. What is Father's Day?
2. Do you celebrate Father's Day in your country? When is it?
3. What is one special thing you like about your father or a father figure?
4. What is a good gift for a father?
5. What can families do together on Father's Day?

Student B: Discuss these questions with Student A.

1. Why is it important to celebrate fathers?
2. Who is a "father figure" for you? (e.g., a grandfather, uncle, older brother)
3. What is one fun activity you like to do with your father or father figure?
4. Can you say "Happy Father's Day" in your language?
5. What makes a father or father figure special?

B. Create a Father's Day Card Message

Work together with your partner to write a short message for a Father's Day card. Imagine you are writing to a father figure.

Instructions:

1. **Brainstorm 3-4 words** to describe a good father (e.g., strong, kind, funny, smart).
2. **Write 2-3 sentences** thanking him or saying something special.
