
### A. Find the Area

#### A. Cruise Ship Areas

This activity is visual and spatial. The answers will be marked directly on the diagram. Expected Student Markings:

- **Circle on the Bridge:** The very front, top section of the ship.
- Square around the Lido Deck: The upper open deck area, usually featuring a pool.
- X on the Dining Room: A large area typically on a lower or middle deck, often at the stern or mid-ship.
- **Underline the Theater:** A large auditorium-style area, usually forward or mid-ship.
- **Star next to the Spa:** An area dedicated to wellness, often near the gym or with quiet zones.
- **Triangle around the Gym:** An area with exercise equipment, often on an upper deck for views.
