### Our Word Library: More Fun Weekend Words!

Learn these new words and phrases!

1. **Wake up** (verb phrase): To stop sleeping.  
*Example: I **wake up** at 7 AM every day.*
2. **Go to bed** (verb phrase): To go to sleep.  
*Example: I **go to bed** at 10 PM.*
3. **Early** (adjective/adverb): Before the usual time.  
*Example: Some people like to **wake up early** on the weekend.*
4. **Late** (adjective/adverb): After the usual time.  
*Example: On Sunday, I sometimes sleep **late**.*
5. **Spend time** (verb phrase): To use time doing something.  
*Example: I like to **spend time** with my family.*
6. **Activity** (noun): Something you do for fun or work.  
*Example: Reading is my favorite **activity**.*
7. **Plan** (verb): To think about and decide what you will do.  
*Example: Let's **plan** our weekend together.*
8. **Sunny** (adjective): When the sun is shining brightly.  
*Example: It's a **sunny** day, perfect for the park!*
