New Words for Our Picnic Day!

Learn more words about picnics and nature. Read the word, its meaning, and imagine the picture!

- 1. **GRASS** (noun): Green plants that grow on the ground.
 - o Imagine: We sit on the **grass** in the park.
- 2. **TREE** (noun): A tall plant with a thick trunk and branches.
 - o Imagine: Birds sing in the tree.
- 3. **FLOWER** (noun): A colorful part of a plant.
 - Imagine: I like to look at the pretty flowers.
- 4. ANT (noun): A very small insect that lives on the ground and likes food.
 - o Imagine: Oh no! There is an **ant** on my sandwich!
- 5. **SHARE** (verb): To give a part of something to other people.
 - Imagine: We share our food with friends.
- 6. **ENJOY** (verb): To feel happy doing something.
 - o Imagine: I **enjoy** picnics very much.
- 7. **SIT** (verb): To rest your body on a chair or the ground.
 - Imagine: We sit on the blanket.
- 8. **PREPARE** (verb): To make something ready.
 - o Imagine: We **prepare** the food for the picnic.
- 9. **LUNCH** (noun): The meal you eat in the middle of the day.
 - o Imagine: We eat **lunch** outside.
- 10. **BOTTLE** (noun): A container for liquid, like water or juice.
 - Imagine: Don't forget your water bottle!
- 11. GATHER (verb): To collect things together.
 - o Imagine: We **gather** our things after the picnic.
- 12. **SPREAD** (verb): To open something out flat.
 - o Imagine: We **spread** the blanket on the grass.
