### Activity 2: Role-Play – A Hot Day in the Park

#### Model Dialogue Example:

**You:** I'm really tired. It's too hot to play.

**Practice:** Do the role-play **2–3 times** and change roles each time.

- It's so / quite / too ...
- Would you like some water / ice cream?
