**Father's Day is a special time. It's a day when we honor and appreciate fathers and father figures.** A father figure can be a grandfather, uncle, older brother, or anyone who is like a father to you.

Many countries celebrate Father's Day on the **third Sunday in June**. In the United States, it started a long time ago, in the early 1900s. A woman named Sonora Smart Dodd wanted to celebrate her own father. Her father was a Civil War veteran and a single parent who raised six children.

**How do people celebrate?** Families often have special meals together. Children might make handmade cards or small gifts for their fathers. Some people buy presents like ties, tools, or books. Others simply spend quality time together, maybe watching a movie, playing games, or going for a walk. The most important thing is to show love and gratitude.
