A. "WH" Question Words

We use the "W" question words to ask for information. The answer can **NOT** be *yes* or *no*:

- "When did you come to America?"
- "Last year February."
- **What** - asking for information about something.
- **When** - asking about time.
- **Where** - asking about the place.
- **Why** - asking for a reason.
- **Who** - asking about a person.
