Part B: Describe the Ride!

Examples Answers

1. The Train

- **Adjectives:** fast, modern (or: long, comfortable)
- **Verbs:** travel, leave (or: arrive, board)
- **Sentences:** The **fast train travels** across the country. A **modern train** usually **leaves** on time.

2. A Busy Station

- **Adjectives:** big, noisy (or: crowded, exciting)
- **Verbs:** wait, connect (or: buy, meet)
- **Sentences:** The **big station** is always **noisy**. People **wait** there to **connect** to different lines.

3. The Passengers

- **Adjectives:** quiet, many (or: tired, polite)
- **Verbs:** sit, read (or: talk, look)
- **Sentences:** Many passengers sit on the train. Some quiet passengers read their books.
