- coupon (n.) a piece of paper that gives you a discount on something
- **produce** (n.) fresh fruits and vegetables
- receipt (n.) a piece of paper that shows what you bought and how much you paid
- sale (n.) a time when a store sells things for a lower price
- scanner (n.) a machine that reads the price of an item
- shelf (n.) a flat piece of wood or metal attached to a wall, used for holding things
- wallet (n.) a small folding case for holding money, credit cards, etc.
