#### Vocabulary:

- **aisle** (n.) - a narrow space between rows of shelves in a store
- **trolley** (n.) - a basket on wheels that you push to carry groceries
- **checkout** (n.) - the place where you pay for your items in a store
- **coupon** (n.) - a piece of paper that gives you a discount on something
- **produce** (n.) - fresh fruits and vegetables
- **receipt** (n.) - a piece of paper that shows what you bought and how much you paid
- **sale** (n.) - a time when a store sells things for a lower price
- **scanner** (n.) - a machine that reads the price of an item
- **shelf** (n.) - a flat piece of wood or metal attached to a wall, used for holding things
- **wallet** (n.) - a small folding case for holding money, credit cards, etc.
