Activity 1: Sort the Words

Activity 2: Identify in Sentences

- 1. Eleanor is a **[happy]** mother.
- 2. Arthur (pushes) the [big] trolley.
- 3. They (bought) [fresh] apples.
- 4. The **cashier (scans)** the **[new]** items.
- 5. The **[heavy]** bags **(are)** full of **[good]** food.
- 6. Arthur (carries) the [full] bags.
- 7. The store (is) [very] busy.
- 8. Eleanor (smiled).

Note: In Activity 2, adjectives like "very" (an adverb modifying an adjective) or auxiliary verbs like "are" and "is" are included in the key for comprehensive understanding at a slightly higher level, but for basic students, the focus should remain on the primary adjectives and verbs as intended.
