



## A DAY AT THE BEACH

### Grammar - A Day At The Beach - Describing & Owning!

#### "Is it this, that, or yours?"

This worksheet will help you use words like **this, that, these, those** to point to things, and **pronouns** (like he, she, they) and **possessive adjectives** (like his, her, their) to talk about people and ownership.

#### Activity 1: This, That, These, Those

Look at the picture (imagine a beach scene). Complete the sentences using **this, that, these, or those**.
