- **cartons:** paper boxes for liquids (like milk)
- **fridge:** a cold machine that keeps food cool (short for refrigerator)
- **cereal:** a food eaten with milk for breakfast



Adjectives (Describing Words):

- **special:** not usual, different from others
- **fresh:** new and clean; not old
- **amazing:** very surprising or wonderful

Verbs (Action Words):

- **cleaned:** made something clean
