Window Shopping - Word Library

Here are some important words that will help you talk about shopping and clothes!

- 1. Shop / Store Pronunciation: SHOP / STOR
 - **Meaning:** A building where you can buy things.
 - **Example:** We went to a small **shop** to buy a shirt.
- 2. Window Shopping Pronunciation: WIN-doh SHOP-ing
 - **Meaning:** Looking at things in shop windows without buying them.
 - **Example:** On Saturday, we love **window shopping** in the city.
- 3. Display Pronunciation: dih-SPLAY
 - **Meaning:** An arrangement of things (like clothes) for people to see in a window or store.
 - **Example:** The new dresses were beautiful in the window **display**.
- 4. Clothes / Clothing Pronunciation: KLOHZ / KLOH-thing
 - **Meaning:** Things you wear, like shirts, pants, or dresses.
 - **Example:** I need to buy new **clothes** for the summer.
- 5. Mannequin Pronunciation: MAN-uh-kin
 - **Meaning:** A model of a person used to show clothes in a shop.
 - **Example:** The **mannequin** wore a stylish coat.
- 6. Browse Pronunciation: BROWZ
 - Meaning: To look around a shop slowly, without looking for one special thing.
 - **Example:** She likes to **browse** for hours in the bookstore.
- 7. Price Pronunciation: PRAYS
 - Meaning: The money you must pay to buy something.
 - **Example:** What is the **price** of that red dress?
- 8. Sale / Discount Pronunciation: SAYL / DIS-kownt
 - Meaning: When a shop sells things for a lower price than usual.
 - **Example:** There is a big **sale** on shoes today!
- 9. Try On Pronunciation: TREY ON
 - Meaning: To put on clothes in a shop to see if they fit and look good.
 - **Example:** You can **try on** the shirt in the fitting room.
- 10. Fitting Room Pronunciation: FIT-ing ROOM
 - Meaning: A small room in a shop where you can try on clothes privately.
 - **Example:** He waited for an empty **fitting room**.
- 11. Cashier Pronunciation: KASH-eer
 - **Meaning:** The person in a shop who takes your money when you buy something.
 - **Example:** Please pay the **cashier** at the front.
- 12. Bag Pronunciation: BAG
 - Meaning: A container made of paper or plastic for carrying things you buy.
 - Example: The cashier put my new shirt in a bag.
