



## POCKET MONEY

### Part 1: Learn About "Will" and "Be Going To"

We use "**will**" for:

- Things you decide **now** (e.g., "I **will** buy a drink now.")
- Things you **think** will happen in the future (e.g., "I think it **will** rain tomorrow.")
- Promises (e.g., "I **will** help you.")

We use "be going to" for:

- **Plans** you made **before** (e.g., "I **am going to** visit my grandmother next week.")
- Things you **see** will happen, because there is **evidence** now (e.g., "Look! It's very cloudy. It's **going to** rain.")
