We use "will" for:

- Things you decide **now** (e.g., "I **will** buy a drink now.")
- Things you **think** will happen in the future (e.g., "I think it **will** rain tomorrow.")
- Promises (e.g., "I will help you.")

We use "be going to" for:

- Plans you made before (e.g., "I am going to visit my grandmother next week.")
- Things you see will happen, because there is evidence now (e.g., "Look! It's very cloudy.
 It's going to rain.")
