### **Teacher's Key**

#### **Activity 1: Riko's Future Plans**

- 1. Riko will meet (meet) her friends before school.
- 2. Her class will have (have) kyushoku at 12 o'clock.
- 3. The students will wear (wear) aprons to serve lunch.
- 4. They will not waste (not waste) any food.
- 5. After lunch, they **will do** (do) souji together.
- 6. Ken will sweep (sweep) the floor, and Hana will wipe (wipe) the windows.
- 7. The students will help (help) each other clean.
- 8. Riko will feel (feel) proud of her clean school.

#### **Activity 2: Ask and Answer Questions About the Future!**

- Example: (Riko / go to school tomorrow?) Q: Will Riko go to school tomorrow?
   A: Yes, she will.
- 9. (Riko's class / eat lunch in a big cafeteria?) Q: Will Riko's class eat lunch in a big cafeteria? A: No, they will not (or won't).
- 10. (Students / clean the school after lunch?) Q: Will students clean the school after lunch?A: Yes, they will.
- 11. (Riko / be a lunch helper next week?) (Your prediction) Q: Will Riko be a lunch helper next week? A: Answers will vary (e.g., Yes, she will. / No, she won't.).
- 12. (The school / be clean when Riko leaves?) Q: Will the school be clean when Riko leaves? A: Yes, it will.

#### **Activity 3: My Future School Day!**

- Answers will vary. Students will write sentences using Simple Future verbs about their own future school day.
  - Sample answers:
    - Tomorrow, I will study math.
    - I will eat lunch with my friends.
    - I will not be late for school.
    - My teacher will give us homework.
    - I will play soccer after school.
